

Grammy nominee to play in Bozeman

BOZEMAN — Mothlight Productions presents two-time Grammy nominee Michelle Shocked in concert Friday, Jan. 28.

Known for such songs as "Ancourage," "Come a Long Way" and "Arkansas Traveller," as well as a fierce independence in her music, Shocked's stylistic adventures have joined her with a long list of bands and musicians.
